## WALNUT VILLAGE BOARD MINUTES Tuesday, September 17, 2024

The meeting with the President and Board of Trustees held on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September 2024 started at 7:00 p.m. in the Village Hall in the Village of Walnut, IL.
